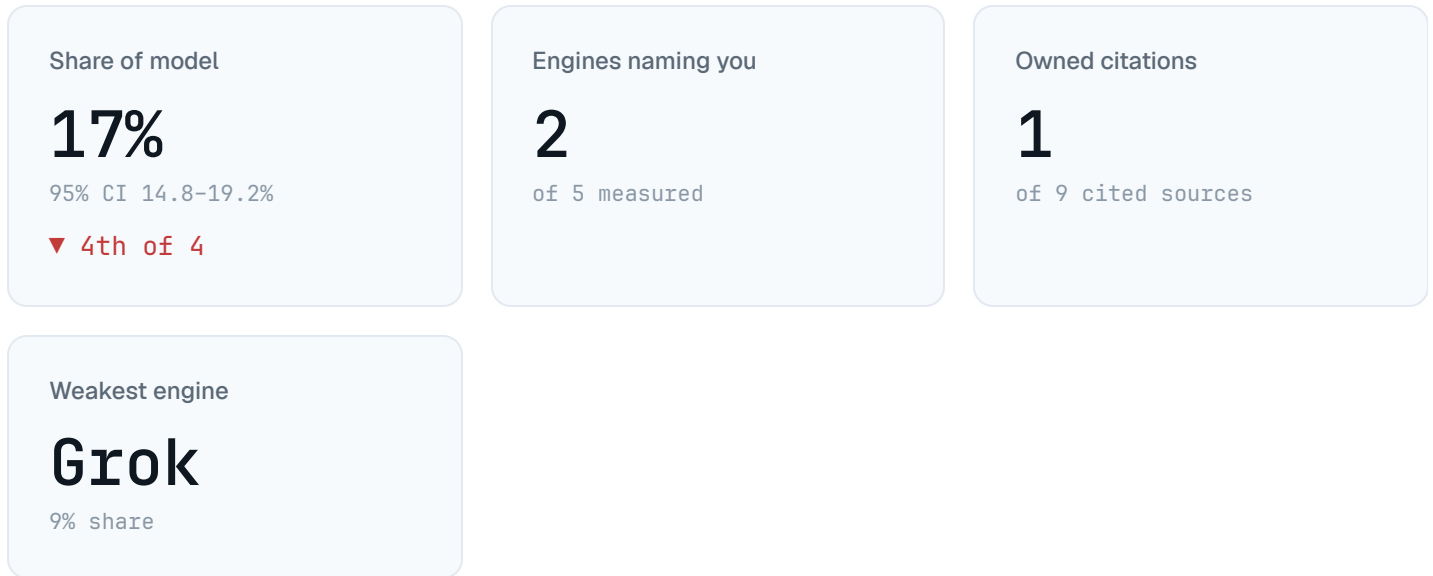
Is Forgeline CI the answer AI gives? We measured.

A public teardown of a developer tool's share of model — what ChatGPT, Perplexity, Gemini, Claude and Grok actually say when buyers ask for the best CI/CD tool, and where the gap is.

 **Illustrative sample — not a real client.** Forgeline CI is fictional; figures are representative, method-noted medians.

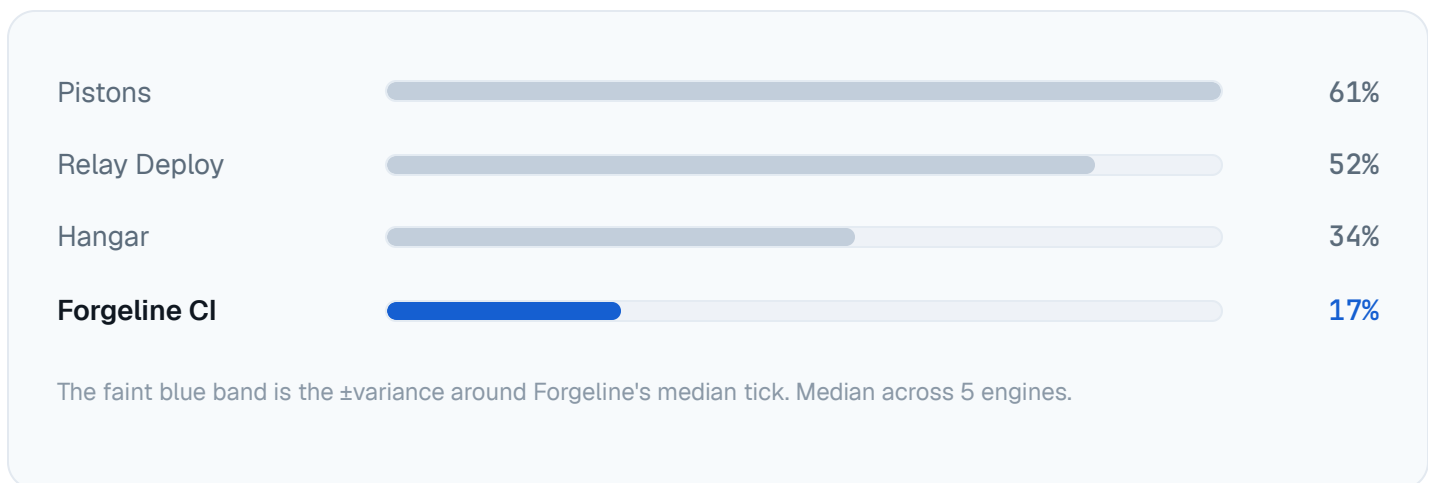
-  **Measured by Clear Cited** — our data, with method & date

Method: median of 10 runs/prompt across ChatGPT, Perplexity, Gemini, Claude, Grok for "best CI/CD tool for a small platform team", personalization off, ±variance band. Measured June 2026.

For a small platform team, strong options include Pistons, Relay Deploy, and Hangar — each with managed runners and good GitHub integration.

0 citations to Forgeline in 10/10 ChatGPT runs — absent from the consideration set, cited to competitors' comparison pages.

Three moves that close the gap

Highest leverage

- Publish an answer-first, schema-marked benchmark page
- Claim & complete G2 + Capterra entities
- Earn 3 comparison-listicle mentions

Why it works

- Gives engines an owned source to cite
- Puts you in the grids they pull from
- Closes the off-domain citation gap (8 of 9 today)
